Joanna Fawzy Doran and Monica Fawzy Bryant have a combined 40 years of cancer rights law experience. Together, they have co-authored the only book on the topic. Cancer Rights Law: A Tool for Effective Navigation, now in its second edition.

They have presented more than 1,500 educational seminars for individuals who have been diagnosed with cancer or a serious medical condition, their caregivers, lawyers, advocates, health care professionals, elected officials, and the general public.

Doran and Bryant co-founded Triage Cancer in 2012, which reaches more than 1.3 million people annually. The organization takes complicated topics like health insurance, employment rights, and navigating medical bills and translates them into terms everyone can understand. Making these topics more accessible allows people to avoid financial toxicity, stay in their homes, and keep their jobs. In 2023, they created Triage Health to ensure everyone has access to this information.




