How Can We Help You?

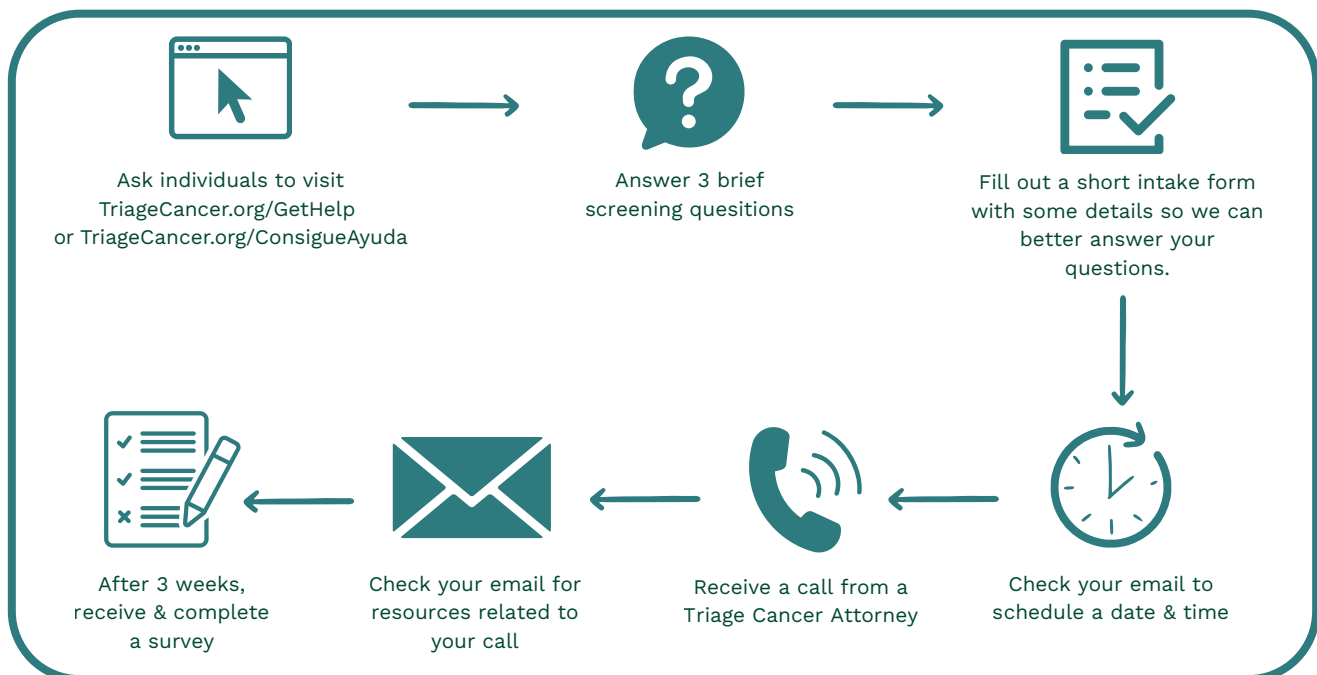
Our goal is to help individuals understand their options and overcome legal, financial, and practical barriers related to a chronic or serious medical condition.

We can:

- Help people understand their rights at work and steps they can take
- Educate people about health insurance costs and ways to manage medical bills
- Help people understand their health insurance options, including when making transitions (e.g., moving, becoming eligible for Medicare or Medicaid, changing jobs)
- Explain common estate planning documents and terms

Alternate Referral Process

- Individuals who don't have access to the internet can call 424-258-4628 (Option 5).
- Triage Cancer staff are typically available between 9am and 4pm Central Time, Monday-Thursday.
- Individuals who need to leave a voicemail should make sure to provide a valid email address.
- Voicemails will be returned based on staff availability; individuals may receive an email or text response.

While we share information and resources, we do not:

- Provide legal representation or advice
- Draft documents or review contracts
- Offer direct financial assistance or complete financial assistance forms
